This week in BLAST, your children learned all about how God Knows Us. Of course, we realize that God knows us because He made us. To reinforce this truth, try reading this rhyme a few times with them.

God Made My Face

God made my face (point to face)
My toes, my hands (touch toes)
I have a place (point to self)
In God's great plans. (outstretch arms)

As a family, brainstorm about some of the things God did to make each of us special. Examples could be different color eyes, hair, skin, skills, etc.)

Depending on how much time you have, take a large piece of paper (the "plain" side of some wrapping paper works well), and have trace the outline of your child on the paper. Using crayons, markers, stickers, yarn, etc., have them personalize their images. Hang the finished artwork in their room as a reminder that God made them special and unique, and that He loves them.

If you don't quite have time for the entire body outline, try the attached coloring sheet of a face for them to decorate. Have a blessed week!
